This to me this was what dog shows are all about. Even if not all the dogs were actually shown, a huge breed entry with 117 Finnish Lapphunds in the catalogue making an unbelievable total entry of 149, I am sure that you cannot find a comparable entry of this lovely breed in any other country than the breed's country of origin, Outstanding winners, a big and very well-lit ring with perfect footing, excellent sportsmanship, exhibitors and breeders with true dedication to their breed and keen to discuss the dogs and the placements afterwards, interesting stud dog and brood bitch competitions and a very enthusiastic and supporting ringside crowd – what more can anyone ask for? Dog shows just do not come better than this. My heartfelt thanks to everybody who contributed to an outstanding and most memorable day. As always in this breed, type and proportions varied quite a lot, as did heads, coats and movement. Length of leg varies from decidedly low-legged via correct to too leggy, but most were within reason. Length of body again varied from square to markedly long, with body length slightly, but noticeably longer than height at withers being the ideal. Again as usual, the number one worry was movement as viewed from behind with only a handful of dogs excelling in this department. I was impressed with the winners in almost all classes, and the top winners were outstanding Finnish Lapphunds, capable of winning anywhere.

Veteran Dog (5 Entries, 0 Absentees)

1st Mr I & Mrs M Mills – Ch. Pajeant Aubenedict ShCM (BOSVIS)

Gold dog of excellent type and quality, a stand-out in the class. Masculine, well-proportioned head with good width of skull, excellent stop and a very attractive expression. Well placed ears of excellent size and shape. Strong neck, correct forechest and return of upper arm. Just off-square in his proportions, he has a very firm topline and a well set tail. Moderately angulated behind, I would not mind a little more generosity of hindquarters both standing and moving. In very good coat condition. Exceptionally true and sound in movement coming and going, at all times keeping his silhouette and balance.

2nd Mrs W Wilson – Bernavia Taika Miekka

A decidedly masculine, dark wolf-sable male, I would not want him any larger. Enough width of skull, very pleasing stop. Eyes could be darker. Excellent bone and substance. Well set neck into withers, topline and well set and carried tail, making for a typical outline. Excellent coat quality. Moved very well from the side, but not nearly as true coming and going as the winner.

Almost eleven year old brown male. Quite well proportioned, masculine head, but I would not mind a somewhat shorter muzzle. Attractive expression from dark eyes for his colour. Excellent topline. Correct depth of chest. Well set, rather sparsely feathered tail, which he could make better use of. Excellent topcoat, but could have

a richer undercoat. Effective mover, balanced from the side, OK coming and going. A lovely character and in excellent condition for his age.

Minor Puppy Dog (4 Entries, 0 Absentees)

1st Miss J Simmons & Mr J Henson – Infindigo Mailat Loki

Chocolate and tan puppy with attractive proportions and silhouette, using his legs well both standing and moving. Head awaiting maturity; puppyish and at this time too round in skull. Acceptable eye colour, matching his coat. Plenty of stop, pleasing ears. Attractive neck. Enough depth and width of chest for his age. Firm topline, well set and carried tail. Balanced angulation in front and behind. In excellent coat condition and correct structure. Moved very well from the side and from the front, if somewhat bowlegged behind.

2nd Mrs N Allison – Oberitz Valkea Yo

Cream dog of very pleasing body proportions. His head needs to mature, including gaining more width of skull and above all more stop. Moderate neck, well set. Good return of upper arm. Very pleasing depth of chest and topline. Well set tail, but I would like him to make more consistent use of his tail on the move. Pleasing bone. At times moved quite well, including coming and going.

Well-proportioned black, tan and white dog of excellent type and overall appearance. His head is more attractive on close inspection than from a distance, good width of skull, good stop, reasonable head proportions and an attractive expression from his oval eyes. Excellent, well crested and strong neck which he used to his advantage. Excellent topline, balanced angulation in front and behind. Well-proportioned with correct length of leg and back, I would not want him any larger. Excellent coat and colour. Sound mover from all directions. He has a pride, a presence and a thorough-bed look about him that makes him a stand-out. On this

form, surely his title cannot be far away, today winning his second **CC and resBIS**.

Another instantly very attractive male, chocolate. He is indeed difficult to overlook as he has that something special. Excellent head with ideal stop and length of muzzle. Well angulated in front, firm topline, well set tail. Coat well presented and of good structure, if not in his very best nick.

Excellent topline, well set and carried tail. Typical coat. Moved efficiently and well balanced from the side, pleasing coming and going. He is indeed a beautiful representative of his breed, and it was a somewhat mixed blessing to be able to award him another **resCC**.

A chocolate and tan dog in particularly lovely condition and truly a powerhouse in movement from the side. Somewhat longer in muzzle, he has a pleasing expression. Excellent ears. Strong neck. Most attractive, well presented coat and in excellent muscular condition. He moved very well from the side, somewhat bow-legged behind.

1st Mrs S & Miss E Bird – Multi Ch Elbereth Kia joins Bridus ShCM (RBCC, BVB, BVIS)

What a lovely veteran bitch, very well proportioned, feminine and above all very sound and athletic. Feminine head with enough width of skull, her ears could have been better spaced and a little smaller, but this is still a detail that does not detract much from her attractiveness. Correct stop. Very attractive, crested neck, well set into excellent shoulders. Firm topline, well set and carried tail. Coat of very good structure, somewhat wavy, but well within the acceptable for the breed. Scoring heavily in movement; exceptionally sound coming and going, well balanced and with more energy than most of her much younger opponents from the side. An impressive, highly typical bitch, well worth the **resCC and Best Veteran**.

2nd Mr & Mrs P Grimmett - Sambreeze Taimi of Wychewolf

Another attractive, well-proportioned bitch, powerful, yet feminine, brown in colour. She showed herself well and was in excellent condition for her age. Not quite the head qualities of the winner; I would prefer a higher brow and some more stop. Well angulated in front. Very attractive coat. Also very mobile and carried herself well on the move.

A classical black and silver bitch in excellent condition for her high age, both for coat and muscles. Excellent feminine head, with lovely head proportions and shape. Excellent ears and expression. Strong neck, well set tail. She would have profited from some more length of leg. Strong body. Excellent coat structure. Moved with enthusiasm and kept her balance at all times.

2nd Mr & Mrs R,J Weetch - Hildrek Siskin D'Ypreau

Almost thirteen year old bitch, black and tan, very powerful and with a strong skull, well filled muzzle and an arrogant expression. Pleasing construction and in good muscular condition, but not in coat condition. Moved well for her high age and seemed to enjoy her day out.

Minor Puppy Bitch (8 Entries, 0 Absentees)

1st Mrs N Allison – Oberitz Vakkara (BPB, RBPIS)

Powerful, well developed brown bitch, scored in soundness and won this class with a bit in hand. Quite typical, feminine head, awaiting development of her full stop. Very good ears. Strong neck, excellent front construction. Firm topline, well set tail which she used well on the move. A very profuse coat of excellent quality, but tending to make her look shorter on legs than she really is, she does not have any more length of leg than she needs anyway, but much better on closer inspection than on first impression. Standing still, she could possibly be passed over, but she truly came into her own on the move, sound, very athletic and carrying herself very well indeed and then also looking balanced in her proportions.

Instantly attractive black and tan bitch of a type that appeals to me. Typical feminine head, excellent ears. Attractive nape of neck. Firm topline, but a bit longer than my ideal. Excellent tail; well set and carried. Very well handled, she gave her very best. Moved well from the side, but her front movement needs to improve with age, at this time rather narrow and unsettled, somewhat better as viewed from behind.

Interesting class with the first two very much opposites as for type and quality, but both scoring heavily in important traits.

1st Mr K Greenland – Samegulds Iris at Rajarani (Imp Swe)

Attractive black and crème bitch with a lot of what I am looking for. There is nothing extreme or flashy about her, she is just well balanced, well-constructed and makes sense. Classical and well-proportioned feminine head, attractive expression. Strong neck with enough length. Firm topline, well set tail. Excellent front, deep chest. Very sound in movement from all angles, quite exceptional as viewed from behind. In quite pleasing coat condition. All over a very typical representative of her breed and sex, she was very well presented, and I seriously considered her for the resCC.

2nd Mr P Jackson – Tilkkuturkin Hallantuoma to Elbereth

A particularly eye-catching wolf-coloured, feminine bitch, but for sure not moderate. Well shaped and proportioned head with beautiful eyes and expression, could do with some more underjaw. Long neck, I would not want it any longer. In optimal overcoat and with a good undercoat as well, she looked unusually striking in her outline with her excellent topline and tail, she stood so very firmly over her legs, which I again would not want any longer. Most certainly a head-turner, she kept her outline and balance on the move and moved soundly, if not quite as supple as the winner.
